FORMAL DRESS UNIFORM

worn on Mondays and special occasions

- Khaki dress slacks
- Long-sleeved white or light blue Oxford shirt
- Navy blue crewneck sweater, sweater vest or blazer
- Dark tie (solid or print), preferably navy blue
- Brown or black leather belt
- Dark socks
- Brown or black leather shoes

REGULAR UNIFORM

worn on Tuesday through Friday

- Tie is optional.
- White turtleneck may be substituted for the Oxford shirt.
- Sweater or sweater vest must be worn with the regular uniform.
- White socks may be worn in place of dark socks.

WARM WEATHER UNIFORM

before October 15 and after April 14 (except on Mondays)

On regular uniform days during early fall and spring, boys may wear the following:

- Khaki dress Bermuda length shorts or khaki pants
- Brown or black leather belt
- Short-sleeved white or navy blue polo shirt
- Sneakers (low-cut with non-scuffing soles if worn to gym class)
- White or dark socks

GYM UNIFORM

- GPA gym shorts and gym shirt
- White, low-cut, predominately white sneakers with non-scuffing soles

FORMAL DRESS UNIFORMS

Students wear the formal dress uniform every Monday or when requested by the school for special events (e.g., Grandparents' Day). Formal dress uniforms will no longer be required on Mondays during the month of June.

UNIFORM RESTRICTIONS

No oversized or stretched sweaters are permitted. Sweaters must cover waist and belt. Khaki shorts must be knee length. Low-heeled leather shoes are required for safety reasons. Sneakers worn during gym class must have non-scuffing soles. No high top or mid-top sneakers are allowed.

FREE DRESS DAYS

Students may wear free dress on the last Friday of every month, or as indicated on the school calendar. Other free dress days may be granted for field trips, class picnics, holidays, etc.
