THE GROSSE POINTE ACADEMY 2009-2010 UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

FORMAL DRESS UNIFORM

worn on Mondays and special occasions

- Plaid kilt
- Long-sleeved white or light blue Oxford shirt
- Navy blue sweater or sweater vest
- Navy blue knee socks or tights
- Brown or black leather shoes

REGULAR UNIFORM

worn on Tuesday through Friday

- Khaki dress slacks with a brown or black leather belt may be substituted for the kilt.
- White or navy blue turtleneck or long-sleeved polo shirt.
- Sweater or sweater vest are optional for 4/5 students.
- White socks may be worn (with khakis only).

WARM WEATHER UNIFORM

through October 15 and after April 12 (except on Mondays)

On regular uniform days during early fall and spring, girls may wear the following:

- Khaki dress Bermuda length shorts, skort, khaki kilt or khaki pants
- Brown or black leather belt
- Short or long-sleeved white or navy blue polo shirt
- Sneakers (low-cut with non-scuffing soles if worn to gym class)
- White or dark socks

GYM UNIFORM

- GPA gym shorts and gym shirt
- White, low-cut, predominately white sneakers with non-scuffing soles

FORMAL DRESS UNIFORMS

Students wear the formal dress uniform every Monday or when requested by the school for special events (e.g., Grandparents' Day). Formal dress uniforms will no longer be required on Mondays during the month of June.

UNIFORM RESTRICTIONS

No oversized or stretched sweaters are permitted. Sweaters must cover waist and belt. Jumpers, kilts and khaki shorts must be knee length. Low-heeled leather shoes are required for safety reasons. Sneakers worn during gym class must have non-scuffing soles. No high-top or mid-top sneakers are allowed. Socks worn with long pants should be traditional crew length (several inches above the shoe). With shorts, skorts or khaki kilts, socks may be shorter than traditional crew length but must be slightly above the ankle bone. Socks that are barely visible are not allowed.

FREE DRESS DAYS

Students may wear free dress on the last Friday of every month, or as indicated on the school calendar. Other free dress days may be granted for field trips, class picnics, holidays, etc.
